Date: 1st November 2025

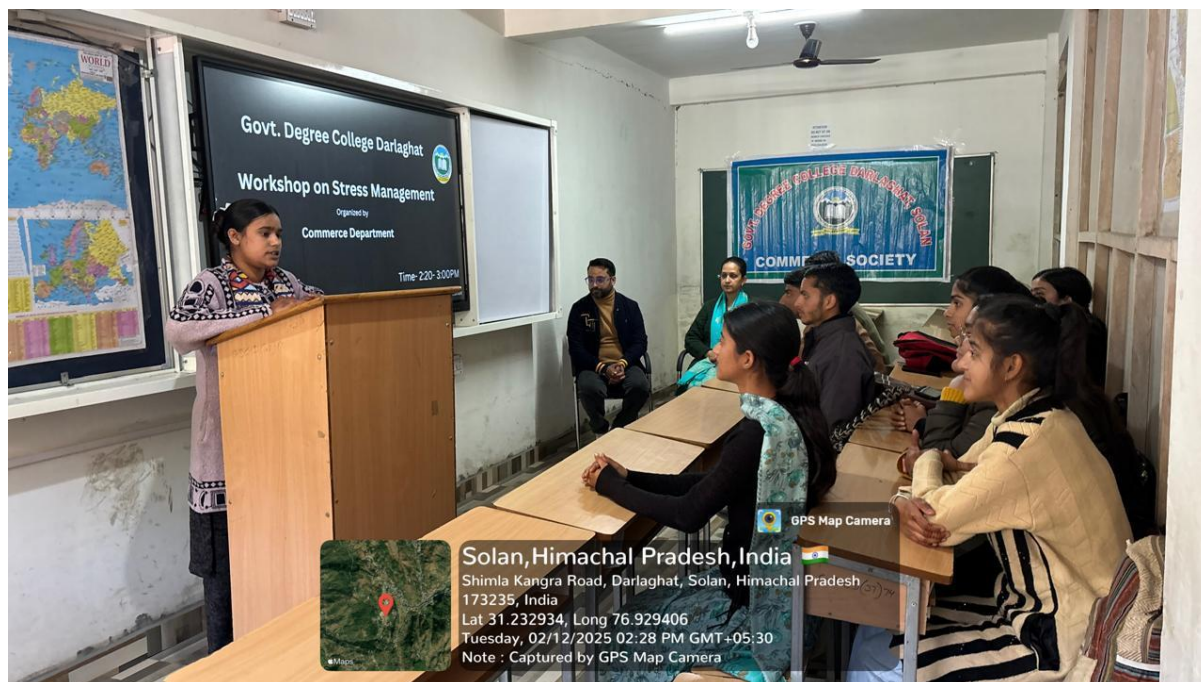

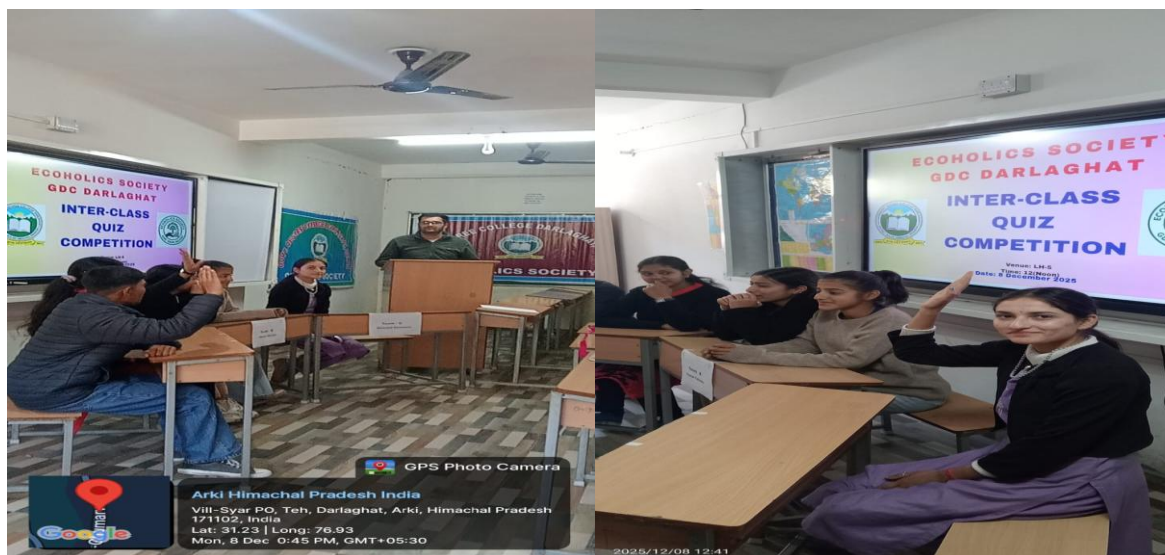


6. Inter-Class Quiz Competition
