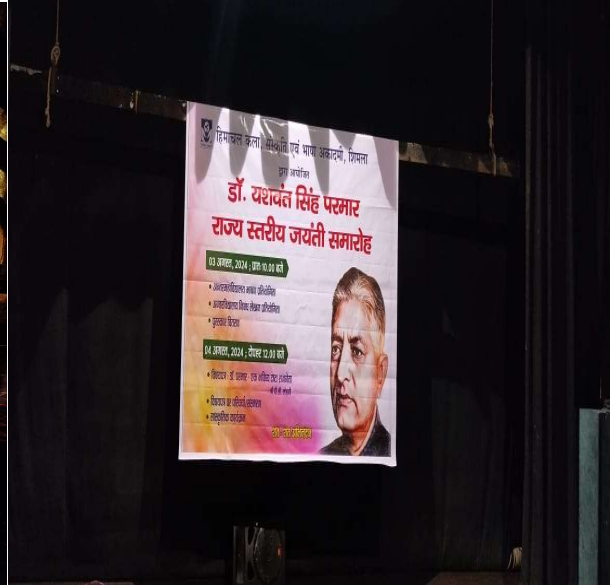


ii. % of students participating in cultural activities

Government Degree College, Darlaghat, actively promotes student involvement in cultural programmes, ensuring wide participation across all years. Engagement is fostered through inclusive college events such as the *Freshers' Party*, *Annual Function*, and *Farewell Celebrations*, as well as through activities organized by various clubs and societies and participation in inter-college youth festivals.

A substantial proportion of students participated in declamation, debates, poetry, poster-making, rangoli, dance, music, theatre, exhibitions, and street plays, reflecting the College's commitment to holistic education and cultural enrichment.

- **3 August 2024 – Inter-College Elocution Competition (Hindi Society)** Ms. Ishita (B.A. First Year) represented the College at Shimla in a competition commemorating Dr. Yashwant Singh Parmar.
- **17 August 2024– Lecture on Hindi Journalism (Hindi Society)** Departmental lecture on "*Hindi mein Akhbar Kaise Padha Jaye*" introduced students to the basics of Hindi journalism.
- **3 September 2024 – Film Screening (Hindi Society)** Screening of *Idgah*, based on Munshi Premchand's story, received wide appreciation.

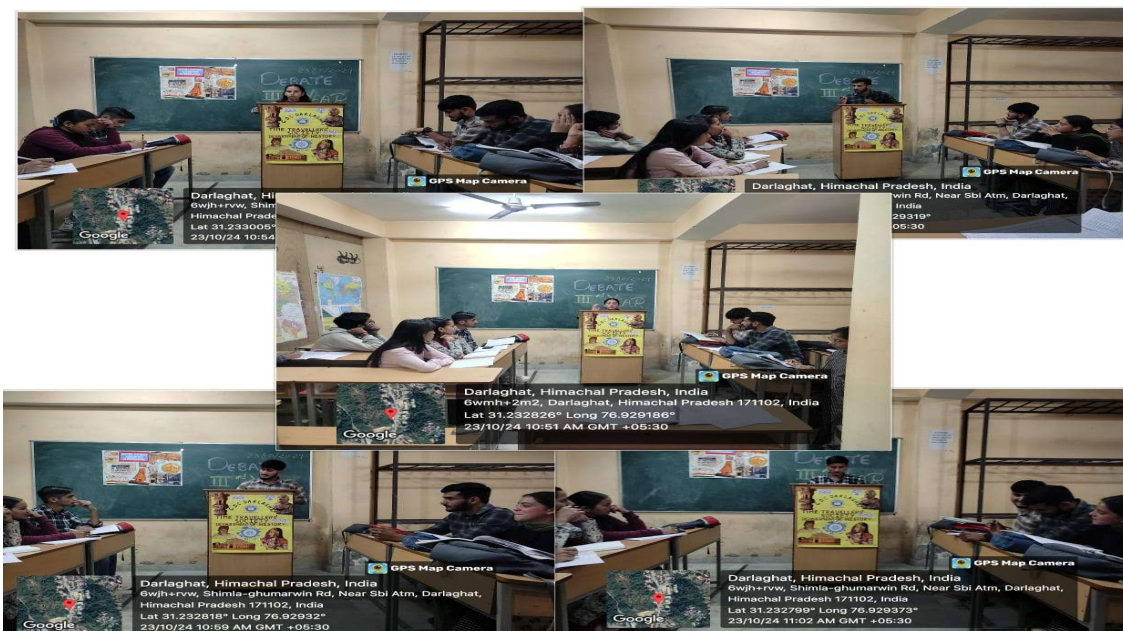

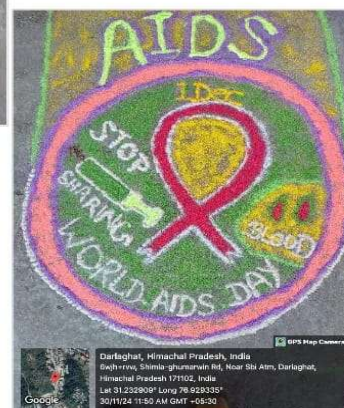
- **12 November 2024– Documentary Screening (Hindi Society)** Documentary on Rabindranath Tagore screened for third-year students.

- **16 December – Nukkad Natak on Road Safety (Road Safety Club)** Street play performed by RTO Solan in College premises to raise awareness on road safety.

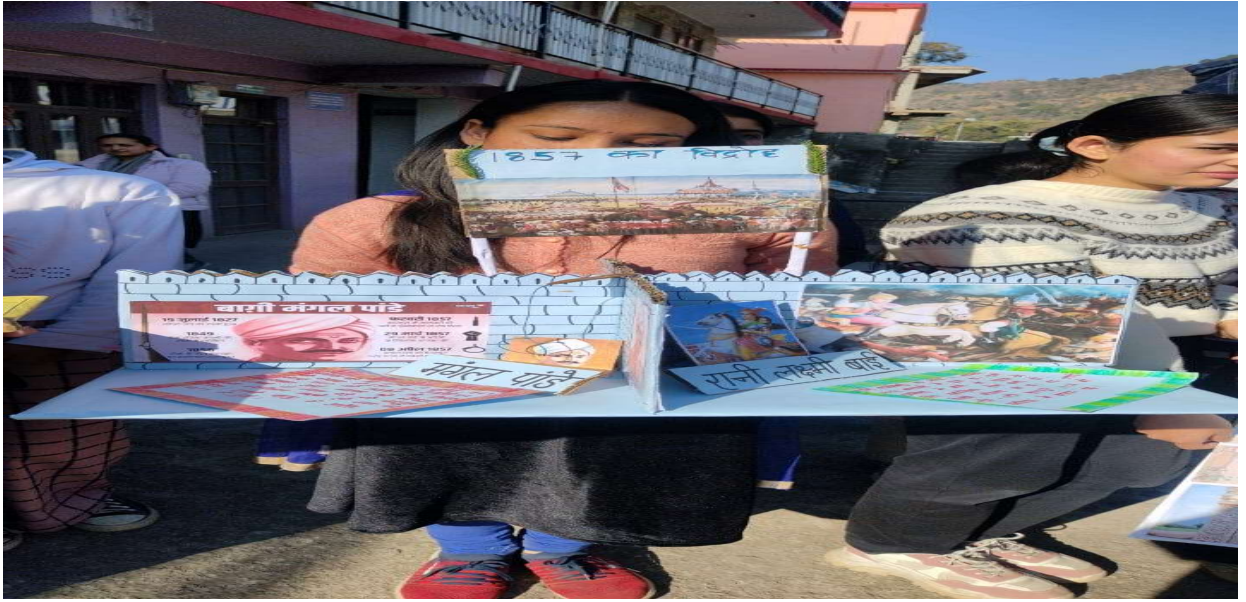
