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Annual Review Meeting Report on Students' Outcomes Academic Session 2024-2025 The Annual Review Meeting aimed to evaluate students' outcomes across academic, co-curricular, extra-curricular, and extension activities during the Academic Session 2024-2025. The meeting was held in the office of the Principal on dated 09 May 2025. The meeting reviewed institutional progress over the previous year, highlighted achievements, identified gaps, and proposed actionable measures to further enhance student development in the upcoming academic session. Key Points Discussed 1. Academic Performance - The continuation and restructuring of the "Academic Star Group" initiative resulted in improved pass percentages and better academic consistency across departments. - Department-wise result analysis indicated overall improvement in internal assessment performance. - One student secured positions in the University Merit List under Himachal Pradesh University, reflecting enhanced academic mentoring. - Increased use of ICT tools in teaching positively impacted student engagement and conceptual clarity. Observation: Greater focus is required on helping learners through structured remedial programmes. 2. Co-Curricular Activities - Student participation in literary, cultural, and quiz competitions increased significantly compared to the previous session. - The college participated in inter-college debate and cultural competitions at the inter-college level. - Active functioning of subject societies and clubs improved student leadership skills. Observation: Need to introduce structured documentation of club activities for quality assurance purposes. 3. Extra-Curricular Activities - Students actively represented the college in various sports events organised by Himachal Pradesh University at the inter-college level, reflecting increased participation and commitment towards sports and physical fitness. - An NSS volunteer was selected for the National Integration Camp, representing the institution at a national platform. - Participation in yoga and fitness-related programmes increased, promoting student wellness. Observation: Structured sports coaching support is recommended to improve performance at higher competitive levels. 4. Extension and Community Engagement Activities - NSS and Rover-Ranger units conducted awareness campaigns on environmental sustainability, health, and digital literacy in nearby villages. - Community feedback indicated strong appreciation for student-led outreach initiatives. - The college organised a cleanliness drive and plantation campaign under institutional green initiatives.	Observation: There is scope to formalise collaborations with local community organisations for sustained outreach programmes. Actions Taken / Recommendations 1. Strengthening Academic Support - Expansion of the "Academic Star Group" model to include subject-specific mentoring cells. - Introduction of structured remedial classes and peer-learning sessions. - Regular monitoring of attendance and internal assessment performance. 2. Enhancing Student Participation - Orientation programmes conducted to encourage student enrolment in clubs, NSS, and sports activities. - Recognition and felicitation of outstanding achievers during Annual Prize Distribution to motivate participation. 3. Promoting Competitive and Career Readiness - Initiation of career counselling sessions focusing on competitive examinations and employability skills. - Proposal to introduce structured coaching support for banking and other government services examinations. 4. Expanding Community Engagement - Plans to adopt a nearby village for sustained extension activities. - Proposal to conduct periodic environmental awareness drives and health camps. Monitoring and Evaluation - Quarterly review of student academic performance through departmental meetings. - Maintenance of participation records for co-curricular and extension activities. - Student feedback mechanism to assess satisfaction levels. - Annual comparative result analysis to track improvement trends. Conclusion The Annual Review Meeting for Academic Session 2024-2025 concluded that the college demonstrated steady progress in academic excellence, student engagement, and community outreach. While notable achievements were recorded across multiple domains, the meeting emphasised the need for structured mentoring, improved documentation practices, enhanced sports coaching, and career-oriented guidance to further strengthen student outcomes in the coming academic session.
